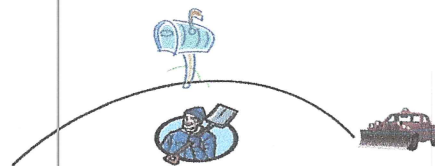


The Village does not pick up leaves so it is not allowed to rake leaves into the road. You can take them to transfer station on Healy Lake Road.

Village of Kaleva—Mailbox Snow Removal

It is the home/business owner's responsibility to maintain their mailbox area.

1. Numbers must be on the side of the box from the direction the route carrier enters the area.

2. All snow must be removed on the approach and depart

If the plow hits the box or pole, the Village will replace it; however, they will not install it. If snow hits it, it is the home/business owner's responsibility.

Snow Plowing



The Village Of Kaleva has a parking ordinance November 1st — April 15th—NO OVERNIGHT PARKING ON VILLAGE STREETS— CARS WILL BE TICKETED.

Snow Removal Ordinance — Removal required by all owners or occupants of any parcel within the Business district of the Village within 24 hours after any snow or ice storm shall cease if the ice or snow results in between 1 and 4 inches. Within 48 hours after any snow or ice storm shall cease if the result is 4 or more inches. Penalties include: cost of village removing the snow, a civil infraction subject to fines up to \$500, and/or a lawsuit to collect expenses for removal.
