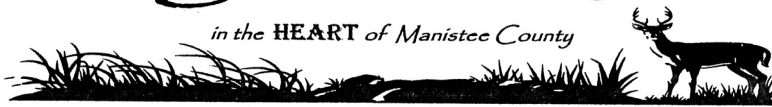

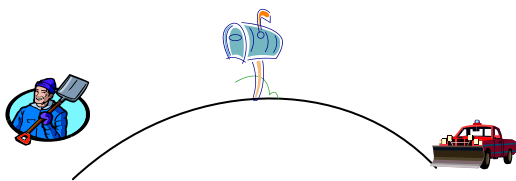
LOCK IT....OR LOSE IT!

Village of Kaleva—Mailbox Snow Removal

It is the home/business owner's responsibility to maintain their mailbox area.

1. Numbers must be on the side of the box from the direction the route carrier enters the area.
2. All snow must be removed on the approach and depart

If the plow hits the box or pole, the Village will replace it; however, they will not install it. If snow hits it, it is the home/business owner's responsibility.

* The average American uses 7 trees a year in paper, wood & other tree products!

Blight Ordinance— Kaleva Ordinance #9 Sec. 4 "...unlawful for any person to store, or to permit the storage or accumulation of trash, rubbish, junk, junk automobiles or abandoned vehicles on any private property in the village except within a completely enclosed building."

Penalties "...by a fine or not exceeding \$100 or by imprisonment for a period of 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment in and at the discretion of the court..."

Noise Ordinance—Kaleva Ordinance #18 Sec 4 "The keeping of any domestic animals which by causing frequent or long continued noise disturbs the comfort or repose of any person shall be prohibited."

Penalties "...by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for first offense or imprisonment in the county jail for a period of not more than 10 days on further offenses."

Curfew Ordinance - Kaleva Ordinance #30 Sec 2 "It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 16 years to be or remain in or upon the streets or public between the hours 10 p.m.—6:00 a.m. and Friday and Saturday between the hours of 11 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

Penalties "...civil infraction and subject to fines up to \$500 and the payment of costs."
