Water Bill are sent out:

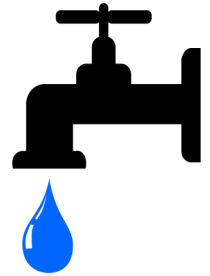
Dec 1st for January– March, payment is due by Jan 15th
