Call to order.

Pledge of allegiance.

Zoning - Enforcement tickets may need to hire police to serve. 6 July ends reviewing of Joint Master Plan. 16th of July will be public meeting.

Planning - Joint planning will meet 20 Jun 23.

KHD - New larger banners are being made. Discussion on moving brush pile for fireworks.

Old Business: Wages were discussed. Suggested to contact accounts on how to account for wages vs salary.

Mowers are not being properly serviced. Will address the problem.

Suggested to start providing Performance Review for employees.
