Reports- Fire: 9 fires have been responded to in past month.

Water: EGLE responded to a chlorine complaint. Found the village was within limits.

R. Schafer presented we have to know how much to charge for bulk use of water. Last time discussed was 5 years ago for \$1.19 per thousand. R. Schafer made motion to keep it same. No seconded. Discussion encouraged. Motion made to charge \$1.75 per thousand by J. McKinley, seconded by R. Schafer. Motion carried. D. Grossnickle and T. Covell abstained.

Park: Pavillian roof is off and steel roof will be going on. Skip for trash costs \$360.00. Act 51 funding is allowed to be used for this project. Motion made to use by J. McKinley, seconded by D. Grosnickle. Motion carried.

Zoning: City of Manistee is not renewing zoning contract with county, W. Beldo is requesting a month to look into hiring them for our area. Requesting information for Village to hire their own. A ticket will be issued to M. Omar and more information on Knapp house was presented.

Planning: Village planning committee did not meet. Joint meets tomorrow.

KHD: They are meeting tomorrow to discuss new banner at cost. Suggested contacting Pepsi/Coke to help with costs.
